The excavations are open to archaeological students and research workers at all levels, and to experienced excavators from within Italy and abroad

The latest date for applications is 30 April 2008

Food and accommodation (bring your own sleeping bag) will be provided, free of charge, in the former Middle School at the village close to the excavation



The 2007 season of work will involve excavation, finds processing and documentation using the latest techniques of digital recording.

The 2004 - 2007 seasons of excavation revealed a religious building and its related cemetery. The plan form of the building and the radiocarbon suggests a date for the church in the Early Christian Period (6 century AD) with evidence of continuity in the Early Middle Age into 11th century AD. Medieval documents from the early 8th century attest to the presence in this area of a church, San Pietro in Pava, identifiable as the structure revealed by the excavations. The excavation of the cemetery of the church revealed more than 450 graves.

To take part in the excavation you will need to wear safety-boots (with reinforced toe-caps) and to arrange your own personal accident insurance (the work is not intrinsically dangerous but regulations require that this should be so)

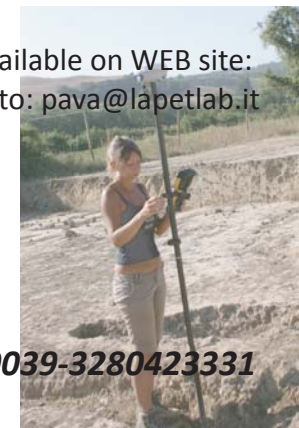
